



COMMERCIAL PRODUCTION FROM KWINANA REFINERY

IGO Limited (**IGO** or the **Company**) (ASX:IGO) is pleased to announce that Tianqi Lithium Energy Australia (TLEA), the joint venture between IGO (49%) and Tianqi Lithium Corporation (51%), has declared commercial production from Train 1 of the Kwinana Lithium Hydroxide Refinery, effective 30 November 2022.

This important milestone reflects TLEA's confidence in the capability of Train 1 to operate continuously and produce battery-grade lithium hydroxide, with recent independent testing confirming that the product's quality meets the required standards for the lithium-ion battery industry.

Product qualification and certification with potential offtake customers are ongoing, while Train 1 continues to ramp up production over the course of 2023.
